This document lists all spare parts and cables that may be ordered for *Cisco Room Panorama*. *

A new main screen model was introduced in the *Room Panorama* in 2023. The product functionality did not change, however, there are a few physical differences between the two versions.

In case a spare part or cable is specific to one of the versions, we refer to the products as:

- *Room Panorama with 85-inch main screens* (the newer version)
- *Room Panorama with 82-inch main screens* (the initial version)
