<b>End-of-Life Announcement Date</b>	The date the document that announces the end of sale and end of life of a product is distributed to the general public.	April 19, 2021
<b>End-of-Sale Date: App SW</b>	The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date.	October 18, 2021
<b>Last Ship Date: App SW</b>	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	January 16, 2022
<b>End of SW Maintenance Releases Date: App SW</b>	The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software.	October 18, 2022
<b>End of New Service Attachment Date: App SW</b>	For equipment and software that is not covered by a service-and-support contract, this is the last date to order a new service-and-support contract or add the equipment and/or software to an existing service-and-support contract.	October 18, 2022
<b>End of Service Contract Renewal Date: App SW</b>	The last date to extend or renew a service contract for the product.	January 14, 2024
<b>Last Date of Support: App SW</b>	The last date to receive applicable service and support for the product as entitled by active service contracts or by warranty terms and conditions. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete.	October 31, 2024
