Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco IOS Software Release 12.2(33)SXJ. The last day to order the affected product(s) is March 31, 2014. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s).

| End-of-Life Announcement Date | The date the document that announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life of a product is distributed to the general public. | September 30, 2013 |
| End-of-Sale Date | The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date. | March 31, 2014 |
| Last Ship Date: OS SW | The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time. | March 31, 2014 |
| End of SW Maintenance Releases Date: OS SW | The last date that Cisco Engineering may release any final software maintenance releases or bug fixes for IOS 12.2(33)SXJ. After this date, Cisco Engineering will no longer develop, repair, maintain, or test the product software. The only exception is Vulnerability/Security issues that will be addressed as shown in the End of Vulnerability/Security Support milestone below. | September 30, 2014 |
| End of Vulnerability/ Security Support: OS SW | The last date that Cisco Engineering may release bug fixes for Vulnerability or Security issues for IOS 12.2(33)SXJ. After this date, bug fixes for Vulnerability or Security issues identified in IOS 12.2(33)SXJ may be provided through later supported software releases. Note that there will be no rebuild releases of IOS 12.2(33)SXJ provided after this End of Vulnerability/Security Support milestone date. | September 30, 2015 |
| Last Date of Support | The last date to receive applicable service and support for the product as entitled by active service contracts or by warranty terms and conditions. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete. | March 31, 2019 |
