Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco Nexus 7000 NX-OS 6.2. The last day to order the affected product(s) is September 16, 2019. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available under the terms and conditions of customers' service contract.

Customers planning to use a feature that is available on a NX-OS 8.0, 8.1 or 8.2 release trains on Nexus 7000 should migrate to NX-OS 8.2 release train as the long lived release. Otherwise customers can migrate to NX-OS 7.3 release train as the long lived release.

Customers maybe able to use the Cisco Technology Migration Program (TMP) where applicable to trade -in eligible products and receive credit toward the purchase of new Cisco equipment.
